

Directions for making the Pillowcase...

3/4 yd cotton fabric (27" x 41")—Body of pillowcase

1/4 yd cotton fabric (9" x 41")-Cuff of pillowcase

3" cotton fabric (3" x 41")—Accent strip

Remove selvege edges of all fabrics. Trim all three pieces so that they are the same width.

Press accent strip (3") in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Trim to 41", if needed. Pin the folded strip to the right side of body fabric along one 41" side, raw edges together. If your main fabric is directional, consider which end is "up."

Place cuff fabric right side up on work surface (it is not folded at this point). Matching up the 41" edge, put the body of the pillowcase **right side down** on top of the cuff strip. Pin or clip edges together.

Beginning at the lower long edge, roll the body toward the cuff strip. Stop rolling when you reach a point about halfway up the cuff. The upper raw edges should still be aligned together.

Wrap the cuff strip around the rolled pillowcase body to form a tube. Pin the raw edges together, making sure the rolled portion does not get pinned.

Sew the pinned edges together with a ¹/₂" seam allowance.

As if you were pulling a sleeve from inside a sweater, pull the pillowcase body from the tube, turning the pillowcase cuff right side out. Unroll the body. All of the seam allowance will be encased within the pillowcase band. Pulling slightly on the cuff, press the cuff flat with seam allowance towards the band. Turn over and repeat on the other side.

Sew a side seam with serger or use a **French seam***. Sew the bottom seam with serger or **French seam***.

* French seam: To make a French seam, place the fabric wrong sides together and sew a 1/8" seam. Turn and press on the seam with right sides together, then sew a 3/8" seam. This will encase the raw edge and give a nice finish to the inside of the case.
